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Hello All,

Each of you and any of your staff who may be interested are invited to take a peek at our agenda for tomorrow's meeting and attend if you would like. It starts at 9:00 am. One of our Commissioners requested items 7b, 7c, and 7d be placed on the agenda. I hear there is going to be a presentation with videos and documents in favor of these 3 items. Our little but loud group of election deniers are in the ear of the commissioner and his wife. I could use some back-up, or a cheering section, or at minimum prayers. The link to the live feed is at the bottom of the agenda.

I would also point out that item 8c is labeled land use moratorium. The content of the actual ordinance is a ban, for an indefinite period of time, on using land for the purpose of performing abortions, or creating new facilities that will provide those services. I expect if you have not seen it yet, you will soon. It is circulating among pro-life groups particularly in border counties. I do not consider myself pro-abortion or pro-life, or even pro-choice. I don't think abortion should be used as a form of birth control. I do think it should be a life saving option available to medical providers. I would not have survived a miscarriage in 1992 had Roe v. Wade not been the law of the land at the time. I apologize for oversharing. I do not want a dozen new clinics popping up any more than they do, but I do not think a land use moratorium is the way to address the issue.
