
**ORDER DENYING PROPOSED
INTERVENOR'S MOTION TO

This case is before the Court on Proposed Intervenor's Motion to Intervene. [Filing 18](#). For the reasons set forth in a Memorandum and Order to follow, Proposed Intervenor's Motion to Intervene is denied.
